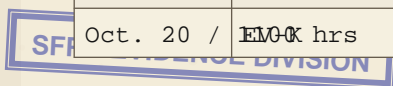

SECTION C – ME OFFICE SPECIMENS (CROSS-REFERENCE ONLY)

Biological specimens and toxicological samples collected at autopsy are maintained under the custody of the Minnehaha County Medical Examiner's Office under ME Case No. 2015-ME-0447. A total of 19 specimens (SP-01 through SP-19) were collected and are documented in ME form ME-0447-06-Specimen-Evidence-Retained-Sheet. Toxicological specimens were submitted to ME Toxicology Laboratory under accession MCME-TOX-2015-0841. Results of toxicological analysis have been completed and are held by the ME's Office pending pathologist review and correlation. Release of ME specimens to SFPD custody, if required, will be documented under separate chain of custody addendum upon ME authorization. SFPD claims no current custody of any ME specimens.
