SECTION D – PROPERTY CUSTODY DISTINCTION AND RELEASE STATUS

This inventory documents property received by and held in the custody of the Minnehaha County Office of the Medical Examiner as of October 14, 2015. Clothing and jewelry may be returned with the body following autopsy and preparation for release to the funeral home designated by the next-of-kin, per standard ME office property release protocol (Policy ME-OPS-010, Rev. 2014). Currency and high-value items will be released separately upon execution of an ME property release form signed by the authorized next-of-kin and witnessed by ME staff.

This inventory was completed in the presence of a witness as listed above. Discrepancies between this inventory and the contents of any bag, pouch, or container received by this office shall be noted in a supplemental memorandum. No discrepancies were identified at the time of this inventory.
