NOTES ON SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS

This sheet documents specimens retained by the Minnehaha County ME office and specimens submitted by this office to the ME Toxicology Laboratory or to SFPD Crime Scene Unit for laboratory analysis. It does not document SFPD-collected evidence items (including the decedent's laptop, notepad, key fob, access badge, or other items taken from Suite 712 during the crime scene examination), which are itemized in SFPD Evidence Log SFPD-PROP-48801-A. It does not replace or

duplicate the ME Toxicology Laboratory accession records, which constitute the controlling chain-of-custody document for all submitted biological specimens. Laboratory accession numbers are pending at the time of this sheet's preparation and will be entered upon confirmation from the receiving laboratory.

All specimens marked 'ME Freezer - Case File' are maintained in the ME facility freezer designated for case evidence, at a temperature of -20°C or below, and may be retrieved for additional analysis by order of the pathologist, the Chief ME, a court of competent jurisdiction, or authorized legal representative. The brain (SP-16) is retained in 10% neutral buffered formalin for a minimum of two weeks to achieve adequate fixation prior to sectioning for neuropathological examination; sectioning is anticipated no earlier than October 28, 2015. Any request for additional specimens, testing, or independent examination by parties with standing must be directed to the Chief ME in writing.
